POLICY TITLE: **Intentional Damage**

POLICY NUMBER: **21** **NAG'S REF:** **5**

PURPOSE:

Lake Taupo Christian School acknowledges a need for the school to address issues of wilful loss or damage to personal property as a result of intentional damage or theft from within the school environment.

GUIDELINES / OBJECTIVES:

- 1 The school accepts no liability or responsibility for personal property on the school grounds, as of right.
- 2 The school assumes a moral and ethical position of fairness for the well being of its students.
- 3 The school will address each case independently and upon the merits of each case.
- 4 Efforts will be made by the school to find those responsible.
- 5 Disciplinary measures will be taken in line with the **Discipline Policy**.
- 6 Reinstatement of property or financial compensation will be sort from the offender.

Personal responsibility

The school accepts that its students have a personal responsibility for their property. The school also accepts that this responsibility for property extends to those who damage or steal property belonging to others.
